Highland Community College will provide the computer equipment and books as required. The curriculum taught will come from Highland Community College Academics Guidelines. All college level classes will receive college credit from Highland Community College. The college credit that you receive is transferable to Kansas University and Washburn University.

The cost of the classes is determined by Highland Community College. Kickapoo Tribal members will be able to use the Kickapoo Education Department as a source of funding to pay for the classes.
